NOTICE OF "DEEMED CONSENT" TO HIV TESTING IN EXPOSURE INCIDENTS

As health care providers, we are required by s 32.1-45.1 of the code of Virginia (1950), as amended, to give you the following notice.

1.

If one of our health care professionals, workers, or employees should be directly exposed to your blood or body fluids in a way that may transmit disease, your blood will be tested for infection with human immunodeficiency virus (the "AIDS" virus). It will also be tested for Hepatitis B and Hepatitis C. A physician or other health care provider will tell you the results of the tests.

If you should be directly exposed to blood or body fluids of one of our health care professionals, workers or employees in a way that may transmit disease, that person's blood will be tested for infection with human immunodeficiency virus (the "AIDS" virus), Hepatitis B and Hepatitis C. A physician or other health care provider will tell you and that person the result of the test.
